- 1) **Politics:** It is a social science concerned with the study of the state, nation, government and politics and policies of government. Politics is "The activities in getting and using power in public life and being able to influence decisions that affect a country or a society" (1pt)
- 2) **Media:** (the plural of medium) are the collective communication outlets or tools that are used to store and deliver information or data. It is a discipline and field of study that deals with the content, history and effects of various media; in particular, the "mass media". (1pt)
- 3) **Psychology:** is an academic and applied discipline that involves the scientific study of mental functions and behaviours. From Latin which means the study of the soul. (1pt)
